Teacher/Tutor Job Description:

Objectives:

- Improve the academic performance of students by providing instruction outside the regular school day
- Utilize input from various stakeholders and key data points, to ensure that all instruction is targeted at individual student learning goals
- Deliver supplemental education services to students in compliance with all Global Partnership Schools, state, district and school policies and procedures
- Set a positive example for students to embrace learning and achieve higher grades

Activities:

- Provide math and reading-based instruction to groups of up to eight students in Kindergarten through 8th grade
- Plan and deliver lessons for each session, in close alignment with goals expressed on student learning plan
- Work in partnership with classroom teachers and parents to establish student learning goals for each student, and to student progress and/or barriers to student success
- Identify, select, and modify instructional resources to meet the needs of students with varying backgrounds, learning styles, and special needs
- Create and sustain active communication with teachers and parents
- Serve as a role model and promote academic and social success
- Explore difficult concepts with students and share new approaches to understanding them
- Utilize appropriate strategies to maximize student attendance
- Complete required student learning plans and progress reports in a format determined by Global Partnership Schools, and by the due date established by Global Partnership Schools and the Supplemental Educational Services contractual agreement with the district and/or student
- Maintain appropriate student records
- Communicate regularly with Lead Teacher for support and additional resources
- Attend of professional development training

- Be an ambassador of the Global Partnership Schools program, by sharing the educational opportunity for SES with eligible families and community members
- Performs other duties as assigned
