

ARTC Proposed Bills Referred to the Appropriations Committee

HB5517 - An Act Concerning Membership Of The Teachers' Retirement Board.

To add an additional two retired teacher members to the Teachers' Retirement Board to have a fair representation of retired teachers on the Board.

HB6490 - An Act Concerning The Election Of Members To The Teachers' Retirement Board.

To reform the procedures for election of members to the Teachers' Retirement Board

HB5524 - An Act Concerning Management Of The Teachers' Retirement System By The State Comptroller.

To increase transparency and responsiveness of the teachers' retirement system on behalf of retired teachers.

HB6013 - An Act Concerning Health Insurance Benefits For Retired Teachers.

To restore one-third state subsidy to retired teachers enrolled in the Teachers' Retirement Board Medicare supplement health insurance package.

Hearing Set for Bill Concerning Retiree Members of the Teachers Retirement Board

Because the Appropriations Committee was flooded with proposed bills and because HB6489 contains the same purpose and goals of ARTC as HB5517 and HB6490, ARTC will testify in support of HB6489 at the upcoming hearing.

HB6489 - An Act Concerning Retiree Members Of The Teachers' Retirement Board.

To increase the number of retired teachers on the Teachers' Retirement Board from two to four.

[Also stated in the bill: That section 10-183l be amended to require (1) the election of two additional members to the Teachers' Retirement Board, who shall be retired teachers who are receiving a pension benefit from the Teachers' Retirement System and are enrolled in a health insurance plan offered by the Teachers' Retirement Board, and (2) that such members be nominated and elected by retired members of the system.]
